## Communication:

- The website will be updated on the home page to reflect we are now open and we will require all golfers to practice MA guidelines for Covid-19.
- Adhere to social distancing before during and after their round.
- Online or phone tee times reservations only.
- Payment by credit card only in the pro shop.
- Golfers should arrive no more than ten minutes prior to their scheduled tee time.
- After play, they will be encouraged to not congregate and proceed to their vehicle.
- Signage will be installed throughout the pro shop to remind the public of social distancing and other significant policies for the health and safety of all.

## Course Modifications:

- Ball washers, bunker rakes and trash containers have been removed from the course.
- The cups in the green will be turned upside down.
- Golfers will be informed not to touch the flagpoles.
- Walking is encouraged.
- Properly sanitized carts will be available.
- The use of a golf cart will be permitted for any individual with a disability. A golfer who needs a cart should provide documentation or otherwise certify in writing that he/she has a disability that require the use of a golf cart.
- Tee times will be made on-line or by phone.
- Tee times have additional spacing to ensure social distancing. Every third tee time is blocked.
- No food or beverage service.
- No merchandise sales except those issued from the case.
- No club rentals.
- No outings will be scheduled.
- No shotgun groups will be scheduled.
- Individual lessons will be available. No youth or adult group lessons at this time.

- Leagues will be assigned specific tee times, the league will assign players to each tee time and arrive no more than ten minutes prior to tee time.
- The practice green will be closed.
- Use of the practice driving net will be available one person at a time.
- League players will also be instructed not to congregate and leave the premises after play.

Staff:

- Employees will be trained with CDC guidelines for best practices.
- Personal protection equipment in the form of gloves and masks will be required.
- All congregating will be avoided as well as person to person contact.
- The maintenance staff best will be trained with CDC guidelines for best practices. Additional attention to safety and sanitizing.
- Starters are located at the entrance to the clubhouse and will monitor the access to and from the clubhouse.

Clubhouse:

- A Plexiglas shield has been installed in the pro shop between the golfer and the pro shop attendant.
- Additional sanitizing of the premises.
- Sanitizing of the golf cars after each use.
- The number of individuals will be limited in the pro shop. One staff person, two public with proper distancing. Only one person allowed in restrooms.
- Masks will be required to enter the clubhouse.
- Both doors to the clubhouse will remain open, with entering on right and exiting on the right.
- The public computer for handicap entries will be removed and golfers will need enter information from home.
